BLEPHAROPLASTY POST-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. **Activity:** Rest and avoid physical activity for the first week and this will significantly reduce your bruising.
- 2. **Comfort Measures:** Place an extra pillow under your head at nights for the first week.
- 3. Your eyelids may feel stiff and your eyes may be slightly irritated for the first few weeks in which case artificial tears will help.
- 4. **Wound Care:** Apply ice to the area of surgery as much as possible for the first 48 hours. You can use an icepack, a wet facecloth placed in the freezer, or a bag of frozen peas or corn.
- 5. **Washing:** You may gently wash the surgical area and use half strength Hydrogen Peroxide to remove any clot that is stuck. Apply antibiotic ointment to the stitches daily.
- 6. **Skin Care:** Once the skin has healed in approximately 7 days, makeup can be worn. Opaque makeup with sunscreen is ideal.
- 7. Regular use of sunscreens with a minimum SPF 30 for several weeks afterwards.
- 8. Do not use Vitamin E cream for the first six weeks or you may widen your scars.
- 9. Once the surgical area is comfortable, begin gentle massage of your eyelids toward the eye and this will improve the contour and reduce swelling.
- 10. **Call your surgeon** (see below) if you have: bleeding, increasing pain, pus in the surgery area, fever, pain in the eye itself, any change in your vision or increasing swelling.
- 11. **Restrictions:** You did____did not_____receive medicine for sedation. If you did receive sedation, you **MUST NOT** operate motor vehicles, boats, power tools or machinery for the first 24 hours. You **MUST NOT** sign or enter into any legal contracts for 24 hours. We suggest that a responsible adult be with you following surgery for the rest of the day and night.

PRESCRIPTIONS:

-	Tylenol #3, Emtec	_Take one to two tablets every 4 to 6 hours as necessary for pain.
	Avoid driving or taking alcohol	while using this medicine.

OVER THE COUNTER MEDICATIONS (PRESERVATIVE FREE)

Lacrilube Ointment – Apply directly to eyes at bedtime for one week. Use when ready to sleep as this is greasy and blurs vision. Remove in the morning.

Artificial Tears - Apply 1-2 drops to eyes, 3 to 4 time daily for one week.
